Please note: If a notice is required to be published in a newspaper, the Brodhead Independent Register is used. If a notice is required to be posted in 3 places, the Town Hall outside display board, American Legion in Orfordville and Town Sanitary Office on County H outside Hanover will be used in addition to the Town of Plymouth website.

ELECTIONS:

2023 has 2 elections scheduled: February Primary on February 21, 2023, Spring Election on April 4, 2023. To ensure you are properly registered please visit the Wisconsin Election website, myvote.wi.gov or contact the Plymouth Town Clerk.

RECYCLING: Town of Plymouth receives a grant from the State for recycling which decreases your cost for this service. The grant is based on the amount of recycling collected in the Town. PLEASE RECYCLE.

2023 TOWN BUDGET: At the November 15, 2022 Special Town Board meeting which followed the Public 2023 Budget Hearing, the Town Board adopted the 2023 Town budget in the amount of \$420,045.

2023 ANNUAL TOWN OF PLYMOUTH **MEETING:**

On April 18, 2023 at 7:00 pm, the Town of Plymouth will hold its Annual Town Meeting. This meeting provides an opportunity for Town of Plymouth residents to express their views, ask questions, and make decisions per State Statutes. This is YOUR meeting! ALL RESIDENTS SHOULD ATTEND.

DOG LICENSE: Pursuant to Section 174.05(2) WI Statutes, ALL DOGS (more than 5 months of age) must HAVE an ANNUAL dog license. ALL DOGS are **REQUIRED** to be vaccinated for rabies. Contact Town Treasurer, Tippy Phillips at 608-290-2211 to obtain a dog license. Applications for a dog license are available at the Plymouth Town Hall and on the Plymouth Town website.

PERMITS ARE REQUIRED FOR:

BUILDING: Contact Zoning Officer and Building Inspector if you are planning on:

- ✓ Building a new structure; moving an existing structure; altering a structure so as to change its use or increase its floor area, including without limitation: garages, decks and patios.
- ✓ Installing or relocating plumbing, electrical, heating, and venting or air conditioning equipment.

DEMOLISHING A STRUCTURE: A raze permit is required before a structure can be taken down on a property. Contact the Building Inspector for a raze permit.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- ◆ ASSESSMENT: Any questions about your assessment, contact Town Assessor, Associated Appraisal Consultants, Inc. at 800-721-4157.
- **♦ BUILDING INSPECTOR**: MZIS 920-675-9062
- DROP BOX: Drop Box in front of Town Hall is used only for Sanitary District payments, dog license payments, etc. It will be closed if absentee ballots have been mailed.
- ◆ PROPERTY TAXES: Any questions contact Tippy Phillips, Town Treasurer, at 608-290-2211.
- TOWN ORDINANCES: If you have any concerns about general ordinances such as condition of a property, unlicensed vehicles, or controlling dogs contact Supervisor Ben Snare.
- ❖ TOWN ROADS: Any questions or concerns about roads contact Supervisor Shawn Mielke.
- VEHICLES: The Town has ordinances regarding unregistered and junk vehicles on your property. They must be removed from the property or enclosed in a building.
- VOTING: Visit the State of Wisconsin Election My Vote website: https://myvote.wi.gov or contact Town Clerk.
- WASTE & RECYCLING: Carts are provided by Waste Management and stay with the Town of Plymouth property. Contact Waste Management at 888-960-0008 to report a damaged cart, missed pickup, or to schedule a bulk item pickup.
- WEEDS: WI State Law requires property owners to destroy all invasive and noxious weeds on their property.
- WISCONSIN ACT 391-PRIVATE PROPERTY RIGHTS: Town residents who want to receive notice of any proposed zoning ordinance or

- amendment that affects the allowable use of his or her property, and property size or density requirements, need to submit a written or electronic request to the Town Clerk.
- ❖ ZONING OF A PROPERTY and ZONING ORDINANCE: Questions on a property's zoning and what is permitted; need to rezone; need a conditional use permit; or dividing a parcel, contact Planning & Zoning Committee Chair and Rock County Planning Agency at the Rock County Courthouse, 608-757-5587.
