## TO CONVERT THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTH FOOTVILLE ROAD AND WEST WELSH ROAD FROM A TWO-WAY STOP TO AN ALL-WAY STOP

Whereas, the intersection of South Footville Road and West Welsh Road is located approximately two hundred feet East of the crest of a hill on West Welsh Road; and

Whereas, said hill obscures the vision and visibility of vehicles traveling east on West Welsh Road; and

Whereas, Section 349.065 Wis. Stats, authorizes local municipalities with "plac[ing] and maintain[ing] traffic control devices upon highways under their jurisdiction to . . . regulate traffic."

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Town Board of the Town of Plymouth, Rock County, Wisconsin, that pursuant to Section 349.065, stop signs shall be installed on West Welsh Road at the intersection of South Footville Road converting said intersection from a two-way stop to an all-way stop.
