Referendum Election Details

At an election to be held in the Parkview School District on April 4, 2023, the following proposed Revenue Limit Resolution of the School Board will be submitted to a vote of the people:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SCHOOL
DISTRICT BUDGET TO EXCEED REVENUE LIMIT
BY \$1,450,000 PER YEAR FOR THREE YEARS
FOR NON-RECURRING PURPOSES

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Parkview School District, Rock County, Wisconsin that the revenues included in the School District budget for 3 years, beginning with the 2023-2024 school year and ending with the 2025-2026 school year, be authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$1,450,000 per year, for non-recurring purposes consisting of technology and curriculum materials, educational programming, expenses associated with bus routes, and costs associated with recruiting and retaining staff.

Ballot Text

The question will appear on the ballot as follows:

"Shall the Parkview School District, Rock County, Wisconsin for 3 years, beginning with the 2023-2024 school year and ending with the 2025-2026 school year, be authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$1,450,000 per year, for non-recurring purposes consisting of technology and curriculum materials, educational programming, expenses associated with bus routes, and costs associated with recruiting and retaining staff?"

Explanation

The referendum election ballot will ask District electors to vote "yes" or "no" on the referendum election question as set forth above.

A "yes" vote on the question is a vote to authorize the Parkview School District budget for 3 years, beginning with the 2023-2024 school year and ending with the 2025-2026 school year, to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$1,450,000 per year, for non-recurring purposes consisting of technology and curriculum materials, educational programming, expenses associated with bus routes, and costs associated with recruiting and retaining staff.

A "no" vote on the question is a vote to deny the Parkview School District budget for 3 years, beginning with the 2023-2024 school year and ending with the 2025-2026 school year, the authority to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$1,450,000 per year, for non-recurring purposes consisting of technology and curriculum materials, educational programming, expenses associated with bus routes, and costs associated with recruiting and retaining staff.

In the event a majority of the electors voting on the question vote "yes", the District will be authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, for 3 years, beginning with the 2023-2024 school year and ending with the 2025-2026 school year, by \$1,450,000 per year, for non-recurring purposes consisting of technology and curriculum materials, educational programming, expenses associated with bus routes, and costs associated with recruiting and retaining staff; if a majority vote "no" on the question set forth above, the District will not be so authorized.

Location and Hours of Polling Places

Information as to the location of the polling places is available in the District Office at 106 West Church Street, Orfordville, Wisconsin.

All polling places will be open at 7:00 A.M. and will close at 8:00 P.M. All polling places are accessible to elderly and disabled voters.
